

Easy steps my organisation can take to help keep Lambeth safe from abuse

Raising awareness of what abuse is and where to get help

- Having a supply of Lambeth Safeguarding Adult Board (LSAB) safeguarding leaflets to give to people we meet
- Uploading LSAB safeguarding leaflets on our website
- Linking to LSAB's website www.lambethsab.org.uk on our website
- Using our social media platforms to promote safeguarding and the Mental Capacity Act
- Giving people information on how to access independent advocacy services if they need support to speak up

Supporting our staff, volunteers and organisation to recognise and respond to abuse

- Checking our safeguarding policies to make sure they are up to date and in line with the Care Act 2014 and London Multi-Agency Adult Safeguarding Policy and Procedures
- Training all staff and volunteers on recognising and responding to abuse in line with our policy and procedure
- Naming a safeguarding lead within our organisation and making sure people know who it is
- Supporting all staff and volunteers to ensure they know how to report a safeguarding concern to Lambeth Adult Social Care
- Training staff and volunteers on the Mental Capacity Act
- Supporting staff and volunteers to know how to access guides and resources on the LSAB's website www.lambethsab.org.uk

Working with partners to help keep Lambeth safe

- Joining the monthly Community Reference Group (CRG) with Lambeth Adult Social Care and local charities to:
 - bring our ideas to work together to prevent abuse
 - find out more on how to seek help
 - get up to date information on changes in the law, good practice guides and learning from safeguarding processes within Lambeth Council
 - directly feedback people's experiences to help improve the response to abuse

- Signing up to the LSAB e-bulletin so that we have up to date information and access to the latest guides and resources to support our work
